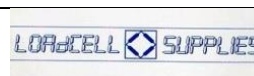

Competitor Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Race office will be open for Registration (see venue diagram) • Kart retrieval will be performed by designated vehicles • Transponders will be required for scoring • Canteen will be open for breakfast and lunch on Sunday • First aid on site • Camping (not permitted unless prior approval contact SKCWA for details) • Carport Shelters available (separate payment required)
Pits, Grids and Paddock	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pit lane may be used for mechanical breakdown (after leaving the Grid) • South Ramp used for in and out grids only. • North Ramp emergency and pickup vehicles. • Driving of karts to the grid and from the track is permitted, in the direction of traffic flow (road) markings (clockwise) AND at a slow constant speed. Refer map • No vehicles under carports
Specific Venue Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No dogs or animals are allowed anywhere within the facility • No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements • Marquees and pop up shelters are not to be erected in the pits without consent of the Club or venue owners, contact organizers for assist. • No unlicensed driving of vehicles within the facility • Wanneroo Raceway is smoke free within pit , paddock areas pit / carport areas and undercroft of McCracken House • No tyre treatment
